

# Dog “Wanted Poster”



I created this Wanted Poster with some of our favorite pictures of our Lhasa Mix; Lacey Mae. She is the queen of mischief in our house so a “Wanted Poster” seemed appropriate to showcase some of her photos.

I started with this cute but basic “Wanted Poster” cardstock that I found at Archivers, it was less than \$1.00. The paper is manufactured by Reminisce. Their web site is [www.designsbyreminisce.com](http://www.designsbyreminisce.com).



I chose to make this ready to frame for the wall since these are some of our favorite pictures of Lacey –we wanted to be able to see them often.

I found this frame at Michaels. I usually buy a few of these when I see them on sale – usually about \$5.00 each. I like these frames because they have springy clips for attaching the backing which allows you to create depth in your design.



I picked out a few of my favorite pictures of Lacey – this one here is Lacey full of muddy water from chasing a squirrel under the house (this was just hours after her bath). I used my Big Shot and some round dies to cut shapes and arrange the pictures on the poster. I used various sizes for the pictures and put them on the card stock with pop dots.

I created her criminal bio in Microsoft word. Here I just had fun with it. I looked at some real wanted posters online for ideas and tailored it for Lacey's "crimes". I printed it out on cardstock with a color printer. I tore the edges for a rougher look and then I stained the paper with a distress ink pad to match the background cardstock.
